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TIME (My Gift of Prayer)

God calls us to be generous with our gift of time.

“Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.” (Mark 11:24)

Our time is a gift from God. Stewardship involves spending time with Him. Recognizing that every day is a gift from God, we strive to spend some of each day with Him through prayer, Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, scripture readings, quiet meditation and other spiritual activities. Stewardship of our time also involves our relationships with others – family, friends, co-workers and neighbors. Here are some suggestions:

- Attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Day
- Attend weekday Mass at least once a week
- Spend 15 minutes daily in personal prayer
- Spend time in Eucharistic Adoration when offered
- Pray together with loved ones
- Have one meal a week with family
- Read the Bible for one hour a week
- Pray the Rosary at least weekly
- Schedule time for a spiritual retreat (i.e. Cursillo weekend)
- Perform a weekly act of kindness
- Participate in a faith sharing or discussion group
- Participate in the Prayer Chain/Prayer Line
